



EVACUATION PARTIAL RESCIND

OKANAGAN INDIAN BAND IR#1

DATE 07/09/2021 AND TIME 11:00

The Evacuation Order pursuant to the State of Local Emergency Band Council Resolution passed by OKIB Chief & Council, has been **Partially Rescinded**, as recommended by the BC Wildfire Service the evacuation order has been rescinded for all residents along Mini-Shadows Road.

Please refer to the attached map for the full boundary of the Rescind:

- The Evacuation Alert remains in place for **ALL** addresses along Mini-Shadows Road until further notice.

Members and residents are reminded that although the Evacuation Order has been removed in some areas, the Province of British Columbia is still facing threat of wildfire in the area. We encourage you to stay connected with up-to-date information and remain aware of current situations and weather conditions.

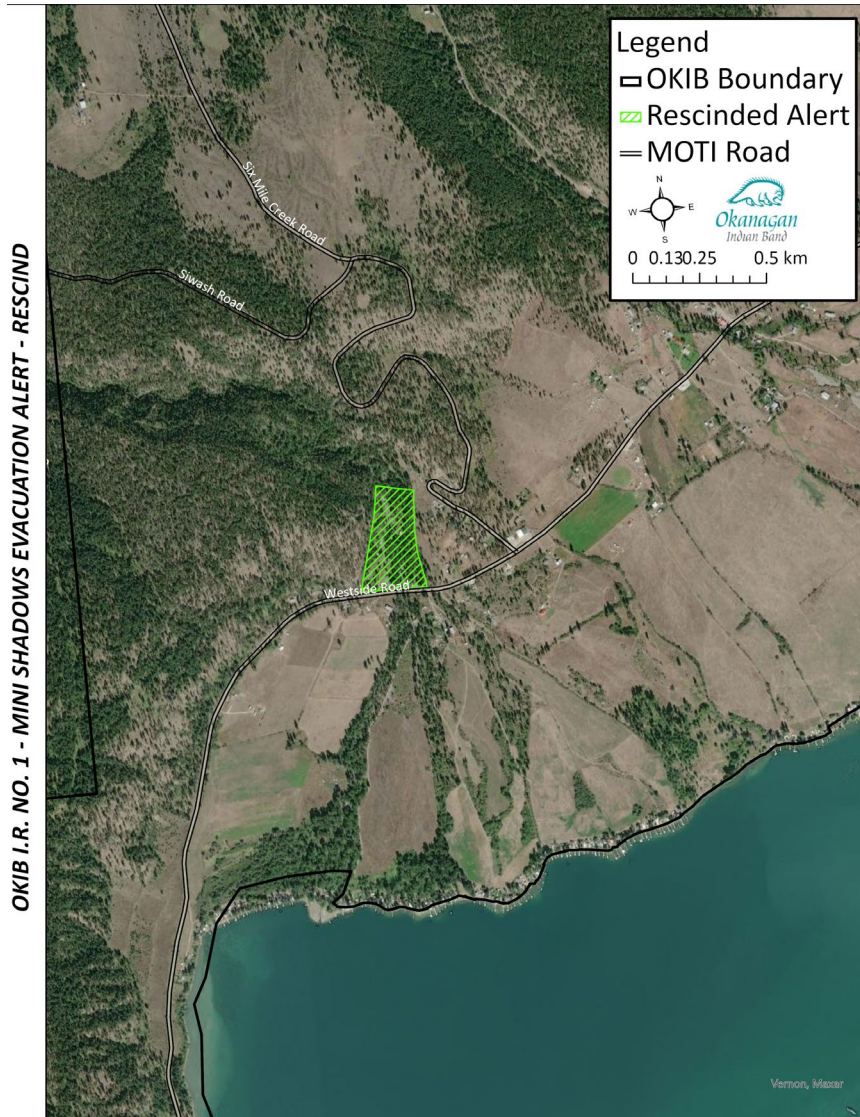
We also recommend that you take the following precautions to stay prepared until the White Rock Lake wildfire is fully extinguished:

- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbors, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members.
- Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- If your animals or livestock have been relocated, call 250-809-9589 to coordinate their safe return
