Samaritan's Purse is offering services to members

The Samaritan's Purse is offering to homeowners impacted by the White Rock Lake Wildfire the following services;

- **Ash Sifting:** They will provide a team that will search specific portions of burnt homes/structures as requested by the homeowner. This task will be carried out for individuals who are looking to recover specific items.
- **Debris cleanup:** They will assist the homeowner by moving debris from the home/structure site to a designated location on their property. **They will not be taking it from the property to another location or waste site.**
- **Other work:** Homeowners may call in and request assistance with other issues that were directly caused by the wildfire. Any work not listed above will be considered on a case by case basis. The decision to undertake any work will rest solely with the Assessor and the Operations Manager.

These services will be provide for homeowners who were partially or fully impacted by the wildfire. If a structure only received partial damage an assessment will be made of what work will lay within our scope of capacity.
