Accepted

- ☑ household garbage
- ☑ items such as clothing, furniture, mattresses, treated wood items, etc
- ☑ freezers, refrigerators, and stoves
- ☑ metal items (metal parts only; all other parts must be removed). Items such as bike frames, bed frames, sinks, etc.

Not accepted

- ☒ automotive parts
- ☒ oil or gas barrels or drums or oil filled containers
- ☒ batteries
- ☒ paint
- ☒ tires
- ☒ aerosol/pressured items
- ☒ burn pile items
- ☒ chemicals
- ☒ hazardous combustible items
- ☒ Styrofoam
- ☒ medical waste of any sort
- ☒ electronics as they are recyclable

- Items will be collected from members on IR#1.
- Items must be on the curbside by **7 a.m.**
- Please put your items on the curbside separated into "household garbage" and "metals" on your collection day.
- Any items that are not sorted into either household garbage or metals will not be collected.
- **Do not** drop off items at the Public Works Yard.
- **All refuse must be bagged.**
