Created in partnership with the Okanagan Nation Alliance, the FortisBC financial award program is open to all Syilx Okanagan Nation members who:

- post-secondary students attending a recognized university or college on a full-time basis
- registered in a minimum two-year academic program and maintain an average of C+ or 2.5 GPA
- have never received this bursary in the past four years
- attached by ancestry and identity to the Okanagan Nation

BURSARY [NRT - BURSARIES](#)

- Available to students enrolled in Certificate, Diploma, Associates Degrees, and/or Trades programs
- Successful applicants are eligible for a maximum of two years of funding in the same field

SCHOLARSHIP [NRT - SCHOLARSHIP](#)

- Available to students in an Undergraduate, Master's and Doctoral programs.
- Undergraduate – eligible for 4 years of funding
- Master's – 2 years of funding
- Doctoral – 2 years of funding

Application intake starts in October annually
