RAM Response Group is a collection of teams that respond to environmental and hazardous material emergencies and the remediation of land following an environmental disaster.

### **Why We Are In Your Community:**

Our response team is currently working under the request of the EOC to collect refrigerators and freezers in the Ewings Landing, Westshore Estates, Killiney Beach, Valley of the Sun and Fintry areas. Our team will be systematically disposing of the potential bio-hazardous materials contained in such appliances.

After Ram's team removes the contents from the appliances, we will be transporting the appliances to a secondary location. ABC Metal Recycling will dismantle the appliances and ensure that the hazardous gas, freon, will be appropriately disposed of.

### **Our Methodical Approach to Hazard Assessments:**

Our team provides hazard assessments after the devastation caused by disasters such as wildfires. We do so by mapping the location and then systematically assessing each property affected by a disaster. Documenting physical, chemical, or other hazards present. We can then mitigate the identified hazards through various controls, such as removing hazardous materials and coordinating appropriate disposal.



### **Our Concerted Efforts**

Our response group is actively working with the Indigenous bands in this area. Our team is striving to provide the support necessary to all communities affected by this environmental disaster. In doing so, Ram Response Group has been granted permission to be present on this land. We, therefore, wish to express our gratitude to the Okanagan Indian Band and to the Syilx people for the invitation and permission to provide what support we can.
