



NOTICE OF RANGE CLOSURE LIVESTOCK TO BE REMOVED FROM OKIB RESERVE LANDS BY NOVEMBER 1, 2020

The Okanagan Indian Band range season is from April 15th to October 31st of each year per the Okanagan Indian Band Range Use and Livestock Bylaw ([BYLAW NO. 1-13, 2020](#))

Any animal out of a secure area when range season is closed will be deemed as 'at-large'.

When range season is closed, the Poundkeeper is authorized to seize and impound any livestock found running at large or trespassing in or upon any parcel of land, premises, or public place, in any enclosures or gardens, or any enclosed land with in OKIB Reserve Lands.
