OKIB COVID 19 Hotline Number: 250-241-7595 or 250-542-5094 (Mon-Friday 8-4:30pm)

- This support is a <u>self-referral voluntary program</u> that any community member may participate in.
- COVID 19 Testing:
 - Is available, and recommended, for any community member who: <u>WHO HAS SYMPTOMS OF COVID FOR OVER 24 HRS, HOWEVER MILD THOSE SYMPTOMS MAY BE.</u>
 - Is offered to symptomatic community members by appointment only. The community member must call the OKIB COVID 19 Hotline number first to complete an assessment and to book a test if advised.
- If a person does not have symptoms of COVID 19, then testing would not be offered.
 However, a community member can always request guidance/teaching and support regardless of symptoms.

When to Seek Immediate Health Care

- If you are exhibiting any severe symptoms and /or difficulty breathing with increased shortness of breath do the following (or any other health alarming symptoms)
 - a. Call 911 for emergency transport to hospital (Best Choice)
 - b. Call VJH Emergency department first and advise them of your symptoms and that you are seeking urgent care. (Only if someone can drive you, calling 911 is recommended).
