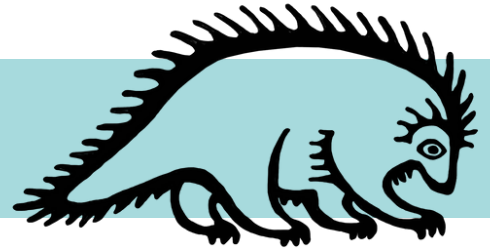

SUPPORTS NEEDED

- Collaborate with fellow teachers on SMART goals, Individual Education Plans (IEPs), Behaviour Intervention Plans (BIP's), Safety Plans, Acadience, report cards, and interim reports
- Perform the regular duties of the Classroom Teacher who you are filling in for
- Lesson and Curriculum development and delivery following BC Curricular Content and Competencies as set out by the Ministry of Education for BC
- Follow established yearly overviews, unit plans, and day plans
- Support the student-centered learning program in place which enhances the explicit programs our school delivers
- Integrate students with disabilities and challenges in a positive and respectful manner
- Supervision duties to include; classroom supervision, field trips, & recess/lunch supervision
- Implement positive discipline when required in accordance with the School Handbook, which includes Conflict Resolution and Restorative Justice
- Ensure children have a safe and secure learning environment
- Attend Language and Culture classes daily with students to ensure classroom management and to learn language alongside with students. This includes local outings which may include hiking
- In case of extended teacher absence, collaborate to complete student report cards and interim reports using school-wide format
- Ensure students work and corrections are complete and assist students in meeting deadlines; follow up on work missed due to absences
- Classroom supervision and management and supervise field trips and other supervision duties as required
- Ensure children have a safe and secure environment
- Perform other duties as required
