



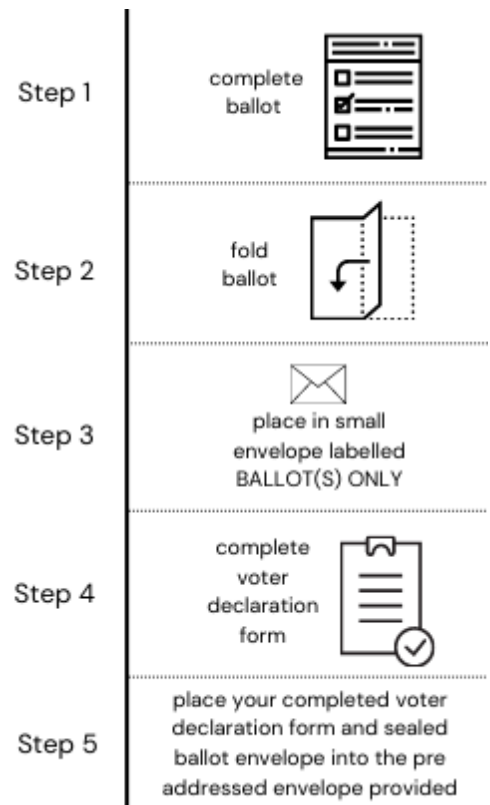
Getting ready to vote?

Members should have received a mail-in ballot package (including a Notice of Referendum, a mail-in ballot, and an information package).

Voting day is January 28, 2021

To vote:

- Mark the ballot by placing an X or check mark in the appropriate box.
- Fold the ballot so that the question and your vote are hidden, and you can still see the electoral officer's initials on the back.
- Put the ballot in the small envelope entitled "BALLOT(S) ONLY". Seal this envelope.
- Read and complete the "*Voter Declaration Form.*"
- Find a person who is willing to witness your signature and who is at least 18 years old.
- Sign the "*Voter Declaration Form*" in front of the witness. Please cross out whichever words do not apply to you under your signature.
- Ask the witness to sign, and print (on the form) their name, address and telephone number.
- Put the small envelope entitled "BALLOT(S) ONLY" and the completed "*Voter Declaration Form*" in the postage-paid return envelope.



Voting by mail: (*preferred due to the pandemic*)

- Carefully follow the instructions included in the information package

- Be sure to ONLY put your ballot in the ballot envelope, the sealed ballot envelope and your voter declaration form go into the larger pre-addressed envelope
- Mail your ballots no later than January 25th to make the vote by mail deadline
- Votes by mail must be received by the electoral officer by 1:00 p.m. on the voting day

Voting in person:

- Please bring the ballot you received in the mail and ID
- If you don't have the ballot, you can get a new one on the voting day by signing a voter declaration form
- Please deliver your ballot between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to the new voting location:
Council Chambers - 12420 Westside Road (next to the Band Office)
