



Program Overview

The Aboriginal Management Program (AMP) is a certificate program offering business concepts and business fundamentals in a professional Indigenous context. Over the course of the program, students will participate in various business courses taught by UBC Sauder faculty and other business professionals.

The AMP integrates leading-edge knowledge and practical, relevant management training with Indigenous experience and perspectives to create an integrated learning experience. Participants will learn key business topics and develop a business model, applicable to their business idea, or that of their council, community or economic development corporation. Students will present their capstone project on the final day of class.

Who is the program for?

The Aboriginal Management Program (AMP) is designed for First Nation (status & non-status), Métis and Inuit Canadian Indigenous applicants with a background or interest in business:

- Development corporation staff with managerial and leadership potential
- Band management staff
- Indigenous entrepreneurs
- Indigenous community business leaders
- Indigenous business professionals
